PROFILE

Economist with 25 years of broad and varied experience in academia and policy.

Currently, I am leading four large **research programmes**:

- (i) with Daniel Clarke (GAD), how humanitarian responses and finance can be secured by using a risk finance approach, including for natural disasters but also for conflict related displacement.
- (ii) with Ricardo Soares de Oliveira (Oxford), a new multidisciplinary programme on the economic and political governance of Africa in the context of its jobs and poverty challenges.
- (iii) with Kate Orkin (Oxford), Alemayehu Seyoum Tefesse (Addis Ababa University) and Johannes Haushofer (Princeton), collaborative research between economists and psychologists on how we can learn from psychology to help poor people to reverse fatalism and increase aspirations and take better advantage of the meagre opportunities they are offered in Ethiopia and in Kenya.
- (iv) with Chris Blattman (Chicago), I am continuing our research on the scope and consequences industrialisation in Africa and whether it can deliver the quality jobs Africa urgently needs.

For the last 20 years, I have conducted policy advisory work, in particular for DFID, World Bank, UNICEF, UNDP, IMF, IDB, DGIS (Belgium), European Commission, DGIS (NL), IFAD, SIDA (Sweden), FAO, on poverty, agriculture, human development and social protection issues, and general development issues.

As Chief Economist at DFID, I have been in the thick of the global aid and development community, providing one of the largest development donors strategic and technical advice. As part of my policy research and advice at DFID, I have worked during the last five years on broad themes of African, Asian and Middle Eastern Development Challenges. Examples are:

- One of the architects of the Jordanian Job Compact and attempts to get Syrian refugees integrated in the Lebanese economy;
- Working closely with the Chinese Development Research Centre of the State Council (Beijing) on the Chinese development model and its relevance in other developing countries;
- Advice to the Nigerian government (Vice President) on how to overcome their currency dilemma as part of the Economic Recovery and Growth Plan;
- Assisting Ethiopia to manage the economic challenges of their growth ambitions in agriculture and industrial development, as well as the economic challenges of recurring drought;
- A framework for pro-poor green growth policies;
- Work on resilient social protection programme in fragile and conflict affected states.

During the last five years, I have undertaken intensive visits, involving context specific lectures on economic development challenges, advisory discussions with government

and local business leaders and extensive field visits to the following countries (in several cases more than one). In alphabetic order: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Botswana, China, DR Congo, Ethiopia, Ghana, India, Jordan, Kenya, Lebanon, Malawi, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Africa, South Sudan, St Helena, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe. In each case I have written detailed internal (DFID) and external notes on a wide variety of issues, as well as opinion pieces in local newspapers.
